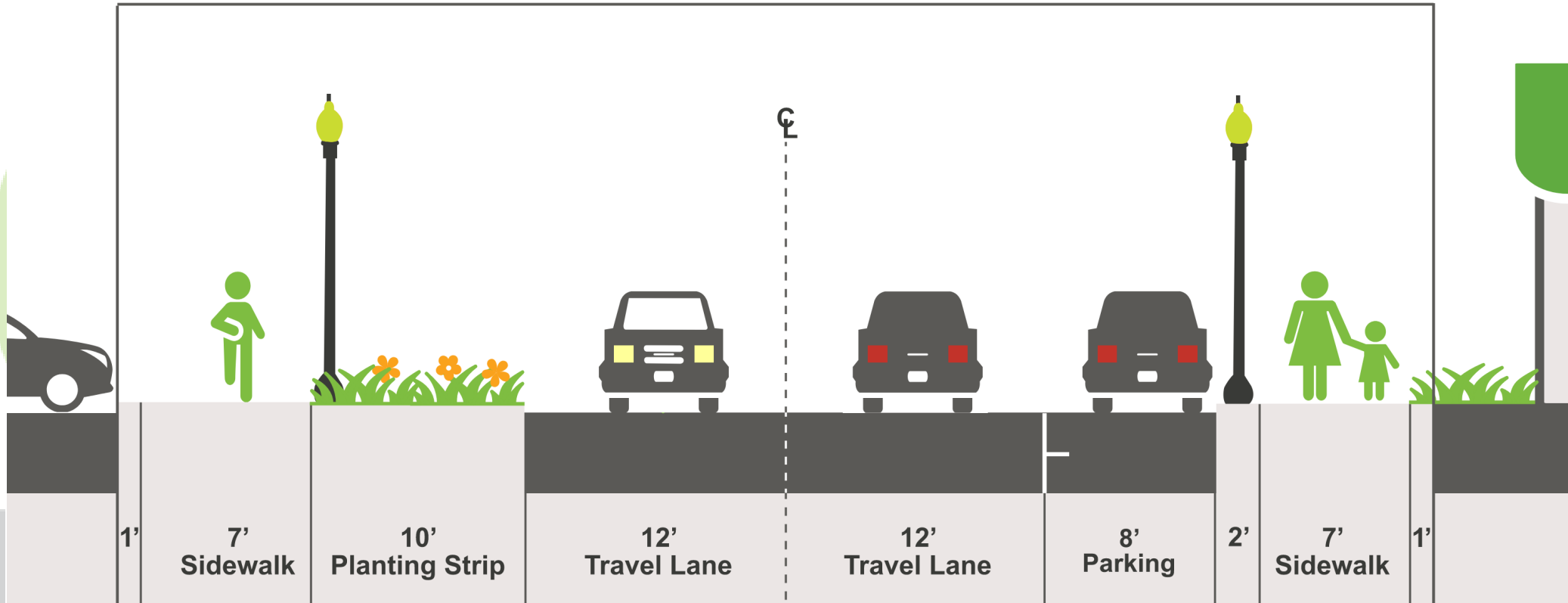


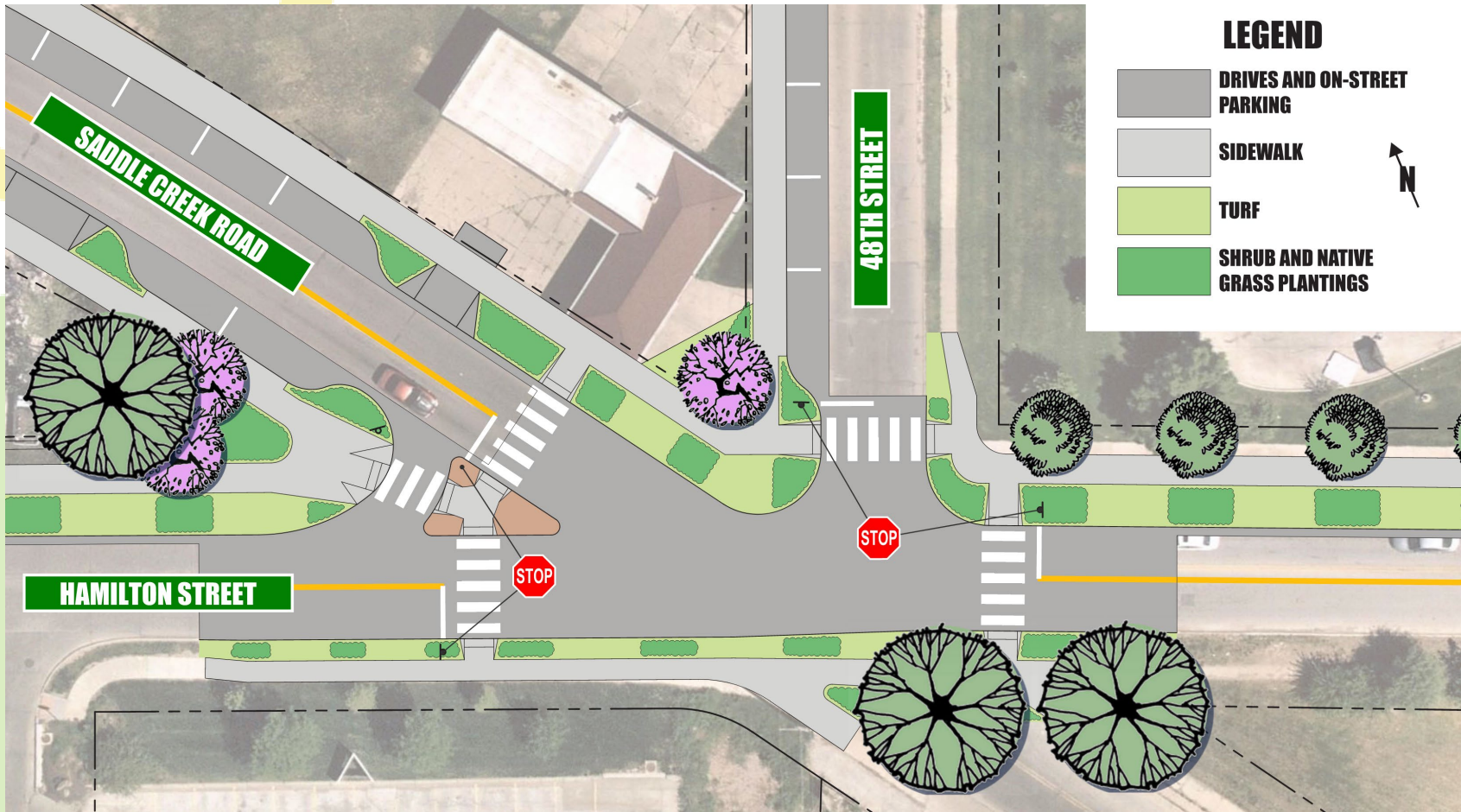
PROPOSED PERSPECTIVE
