Scope of Work

The proposed project will construct new sidewalks, pedestrian-scale lighting, landscaping, and on-street parallel parking. Additionally, space will be created for public amenities such as benches and bicycle parking. Dedicated bike facilities have been added to the project scope. The goal of this project is to make enhancements to the area's current streetscape and improve the overall safety.




Accommodation of Traffic

Sidewalk and driveway closures would be required along Saddle Creek Road from 50th Street to Hamilton Street within the construction limits. However, access to businesses are intended to remain open throughout construction. Alternate routes may need to be utilized during construction to accommodate lane closures. At least one lane will remain open.



Estimated Costs

The estimated cost of construction for the Saddle Creek Road project is approximately \$5.8 million. Funding would derive from American Rescue Plan Act and local public and private sources.


